Community College

Community colleges offer classes for students who will enter careers that require certain certificates for which they must attend college for two years or less, like paramedics, preschool teachers, and doctor-office nurses.

Also, students who are working toward a four-year degree may take up to two

years of classes at a community college before they transfer to a university to complete their degree.

Community colleges are sometimes called junior colleges. They accept all students.

Community college classes are the least expensive college classes available in California. They are run by the state of California, and tax money pays for them.
